Dear Dr. Hofferbert:

At its meeting of June 8, 1972 the Chancellor's Council of Presidents endorsed a system membership in ICPR for The California State University and Colleges. The Council also approved the proposed funding plan for the 1972-73 fiscal year beginning July 1, 1972.

As you noted in your letter of June 3, 1972 to me, it is quite impossible for us to commit the system firmly for more than one year at a time. However, be assured that we anticipate a continuing arrangement with ICPR over the years.

Your suggestion that we mutually review the mechanisms for cooperation at least annually is wholeheartedly accepted. We feel certain that frequent conversations will be necessary, if we are to find those procedures which will optimize the likelihood of achieving our mutual goals. Thank you for the offer of consultation and assistance, we will no doubt seek those services soon.

We have already begun to explore ways to maintain accounting data on the usage of ICPR materials. This information is as important to us as it is to the consortium. You will, of course, be provided such data at regular intervals.
